
Mayor Pro Tempore / Councilmember Doug Head led with a prayer and then the pledge of allegiance. Mr. Head called the meeting to order and was in attendance with Councilmembers Don Greathouse, Jeff Middlebrooks, Ryan Tucker, and Lakeitha Reeves. Others in attendance included: Russell Thompson, City Manager; Deann Wheeler, City Attorney; Mike Richardson, Police Chief; Sidney Corley, Police Major; Dave Piper with radio station Fun 101.1; and Oasis Nichols, Deputy City Clerk.

Councilmember Greathouse motioned first to continue the school zone RedSpeed system. Mayor Pro Tempore / Councilmember Head seconded that motion. Councilmember Middlebrooks voted no and all other councilmembers voted yes.

Other business to be discussed – Mr. Thompson mentioned that the US department of Agriculture is requiring the city to collect data on employees and residents of the city. This is a requirement as part of sewer improvement program. They are also requiring the city to add an optional survey on the utility application to include age, race, sex and sexual preference.

Councilmember Doug Head asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Councilmember Tucker made the first motion. Councilmember Greathouse seconded that motion. The meeting was adjourned at 12:46pm.
