

MINUTES OF A SPECIAL CALLED MEETING OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL

May 21, 2021 at 8:00AM


A special called meeting of the Thomaston Mayor and City Council was held on Friday, May 21, 2021, at 8:00am on the second floor of the Thomaston-Upson Government Complex, in the City Manager's breakroom. This meeting was open to the public as well as livestreamed on The Thomason City YouTube Channel.

Mayor J.D. Stallings called the meeting to order and was in attendance with Councilmembers Don Greathouse, Jeff Middlebrooks, Lakeitha Reeves, and Doug Head. Councilmember Ryan Tucker was not present. Others in attendance included: Russell Thompson, City Manager; Deann Wheeler, City Attorney; and Oasis Nichols, Deputy City Clerk.

This meeting was more of a work session meeting where the two topics discussed were the city-county sewer contract and clarification of intent of the alcohol licenses – moratorium. The city-county sewer contract was broken down and explained by section as well as discussion of the contract terms. The consensus of Mayor and City Council when it came to the clarification of intent of the alcohol licenses – moratorium was that no new licenses should be issued by the City of Thomaston for the businesses listed under the moratorium until after the November 3rd 2021 expiration date. No action was taken at this meeting.

There was no other business to be discussed. Mayor Stallings asked for a motion to adjourn the meeting. Councilmember Head made the first motion. Councilmember Greathouse seconded that motion. The meeting was adjourned at 9:23am.
