**July 2, 2021 at 9:00AM**


A special called meeting of the Thomaston Mayor and City Council was held on Friday, July 2, 2021, at 9:00am on the main floor of the Thomaston-Upson Government Complex, in the City-County meeting room. Mayor J.D. Stallings called the meeting to order and was in attendance with Councilmembers Don Greathouse, Jeff Middlebrooks, Lakeitha Reeves, and Doug Head.
